

Preparing Your Closet

Tips on making your Simply Closets installation as simple as possible.



Step 1: Clean out your closet

Remove items you do not need anymore. For clothes, a good rule of thumb is if it's not worn in two years, it's time to part with them. Donate items to charity or pass them on to friends or family.



Step 2: Paint

If you decide to paint your closet, make sure all the items are removed and strip the closet of it's shelving, pole, cleats and brackets.



Step 3: Remove Fixtures

*Remove fixtures, patch nail holes and paint at least one day before installation. We will remove the fixtures if you decide not to paint but please note that **we will not** repair or paint walls so there may be some wall damage before installation.*

If you wish to save the old shelving we take out, please let your installer know before he or she begins.



Step 4: Remove valuables from adjoining walls

Pictures hanging on the walls opposite your closet could get damaged during installation. We will be as careful as possible but it would be best to take them down as a precaution.



Step 5: Enjoy your new closet

You can move your items into your new custom closet as soon as we are finished with the installation.



Step 6: Stay in touch

You may want to make adjustments or additions to your closet as your needs change. Stay in touch to make the most of your space.
